TIP OF THE MONTH

When color planning your rug, consider hooking the main motifs in neutral tones; this allows for a greater license to really play with bold color in the background. Think about applying different color schemes such as a triadic color scheme, or a double complimentary color scheme. A good color wheel is a must have tool and can help guide an adventurous hooker through the endless choice of color combinations.
